


#### **Our mission**



# Big questions for field of social innovation, right now

- Better funding mechanisms

- Space for experimentation (and new approaches to risk management)
- Understanding who else is working in the system and how we can collaborate
- Better knowledge and learning of who is doing what and how, and how projects can be replicated
